

Update



"DISCOVERY" PROGRAMME

After much prayerful consideration, following our review of the GBS ministry, the difficult decision was taken to withdraw "Discovery" broadcasts from TWR UK and TWR Benin from the end of March 2017. This means that the programme will no longer be available on those stations to listeners in the UK, Ireland and Europe, and in Ghana and Nigeria. Those with Internet access will still be able to listen via TWR Africa on-line.

This will enable us to continue the weekly broadcasts into southern Africa and West Africa via TWR Africa over short wave, two satellite outlets and the Internet. The programme is broadcast from time to time on a daily basis (Monday to Friday) by Flame CCR on the Wirral.

A number of factors have influenced this decision:

The number of similar programmes available today has greatly reduced potential listeners and response to the programme has consequently been decreasing over the past two to three years, although those who have responded invariably express their appreciation for the clear teaching given and the literature supplied.

The cost of broadcasting (our main expense) is inevitably increasing and our expenditure is exceeding our income most months.

We give the Lord all the praise for more than 60 years of reaching out by radio into many different parts of the world and for the thousands of responses received over that time and for the thousands of booklet sent out as follow-up.

We believe that the Lord is now leading us to consider other avenues for making the "Discovery" material more widely available -

Broadcasting

Malawi officially the **Republic of Malawi**, is a landlocked country in southeast Africa that was formerly known as Nyasaland. It is bordered by Zambia to the northwest, Tanzania to the northeast, and Mozambique on the east, south and west. The country is separated from Tanzania and Mozambique by Lake Malawi. Malawi is over 118,000 km (45,560 sq mi) with an estimated population of 16,777,547 (July 2013 est.). Its capital is Lilongwe, which is also Malawi's largest city; the second largest is Blantyre, the third is Mzuzu and the fourth largest is its old capital Zomba.

The name Malawi comes from the Maravi, an old name of the Nyanja people that inhabit the area. The country is also nicknamed "The Warm Heart of Africa". Malawi is among the smallest countries in Africa. Lake Malawi takes about a third of Malawi's area.

Malawi is a majority Christian country, with a significant Muslim minority, although the exact figures are disputed. There is limited data with widely varying estimates on religious affiliation in the country. According to the Malawi Religion Project run by the University of Pennsylvania in 2010, approximately 68% of the population identify as Christians, 25% as Muslim and 5% as "other".

"DISCOVERY" is heard in Malawi every Sunday evening over the Trans World Radio Malawi FM Network.

This comprises five stations in Blantyre, Dedza, Mvera, Ntchisi and Zomba.

Please remember these broadcasts in your prayers that listeners will be grounded in God's Word.
